Lions Quest Program

Lions Quest, a life-skills program for children from kindergarten to 12th grade, teaches youths how to make responsible decisions, communicate effectively and avoid drugs. Lions originally partnered with Quest International in 1984. Lions Clubs International Foundation acquired the rights to Lions Quest in 2002 to increase the program's reach and offer greater support and visibility for the Lions who work with their local schools and communities on the program.

Lions Quest Results

- Improved achievement test scores
- Change in knowledge, attitudes, and beliefs regarding substance abuse and violence
- Lower rates of disciplinary problems
- Lower risk of dropping out of school
- Decreased use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs
